

LTC Anthony Mault is from Portsmouth, Va. He began his military service in 1984 as an enlisted infantryman in the 5th Infantry Division at Fort Polk, La.

Mault is a ROTC Distinguished Military Graduate from Northwestern State University of Louisiana where he received his commission in the air defense artillery in 1990. Mault served as a vulcan platoon leader in 3rd Battalion, 3rd Air Defense Artillery (Vulcan/Stinger), 5th Infantry Division, Fort Polk, La. The battalion was designated 2nd Battalion, 5th Air Defense Artillery (Bradley/Stinger), 2nd Armored Division and moved to Fort Hood, Texas, where he served as battery executive officer and battalion assistant S3. Following the Air Defense Artillery Advanced Course, Mault served as assistant S3 with 69th Air Defense Artillery Brigade, Giebelstadt, Germany. Later, he commanded Echo Battery, 6th Battalion, 52nd Air Defense Artillery (PATRIOT) in Ansbach, Germany. Mault served as the operations officer for 1st Battalion, 346th Regiment (ADA), Camp Shelby, Miss., from 1999 to 2002 and as an Assistant Professor of Military Science at the University of Southern Mississippi from 2002 to 2005. Mault later served with the 3rd Brigade Combat Team (Rakkasans), 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault), serving as the brigade's air defense officer/assistant S3 and OIC of the Air Defense Airspace Management Cell (ADAM) during the BCT's transformation and deployment in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom 2005-2007. From 2007 to 2010, Mault commanded 1st Battalion, 346th Regiment (ADA), Camp Shelby Joint Forces Training Center, Miss., where the battalion trained mobilized Soldiers, Sailors, and Airmen in Counter Improvised Explosive Device (CIED) defeat and Blue Force Tracker (BFT).

Mault's last assignment was with 4th IBCT, 10th Mountain Division (LI), Fort Polk, La., where he served as a Security Force Assistance Advisor Team (SFA AT) Chief and deployed to Bamyan Province, Afghanistan. Mault currently serves as the brigade operations officer and the 1-346th Regiment Battalion Commander.

Mault's awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal (1OLC); Meritorious Service Medal (3OLC); Army Commendation Medal (1OLC); Army Achievement Medal (6OLC); Expert Infantryman's Badge; Airborne and Air Assault Badge.
